VISITING AN OSTEOPATH



When to seek treatment

The sooner you come with a problem, the more likely treatment will work quickly.

You do not need a referral from a GP to visit an Osteopath.

What conditions can be treated

Osteopaths treat people not diseases. Most people seek osteopathic treatment when they have pain or stiffness. Common problems include:

Pain in areas such as back, neck, hips or shoulders including stiffness.

Workplace strains

Sports injuries

Backache experienced during pregnancy

Symptoms of chronic conditions, e.g., arthritis and many others



Who can be treated

Anyone from babies through to the elderly can benefit from osteopathy. The treatment is non invasive and doesn't involve the use of drugs.

AT THE OSTEOPATHY CLINIC



Prior to treatment

The student osteopath will talk to you to discuss your symptoms. They will ask questions about your overall health. With your agreement they will then make a physical examination. At the LSO this assessment is carried out by a senior student.

During treatment

Once the student osteopath has completed the physical examination they will discuss their findings with their clinical tutor. A course of treatment may be recommended.

Providing you are in agreement, a treatment protocol can then be implemented. Most of the treatment approaches are manual, hands-on approaches. The student will also offer guidance and advice.



After treatment

Some people get immediate relief from their symptoms, for others it can take longer. It is possible that you might feel a little soreness after osteopathic treatment – this is fairly normal and usually self resolves within 24-48 hours.
